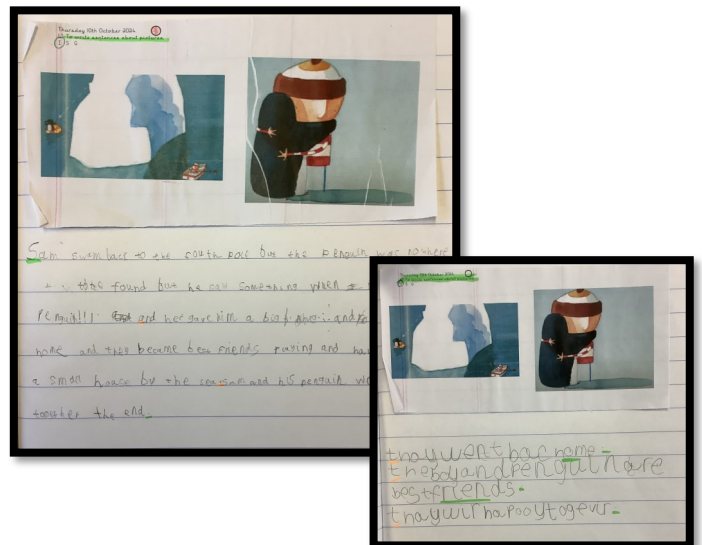
YEAR 1 - Maple

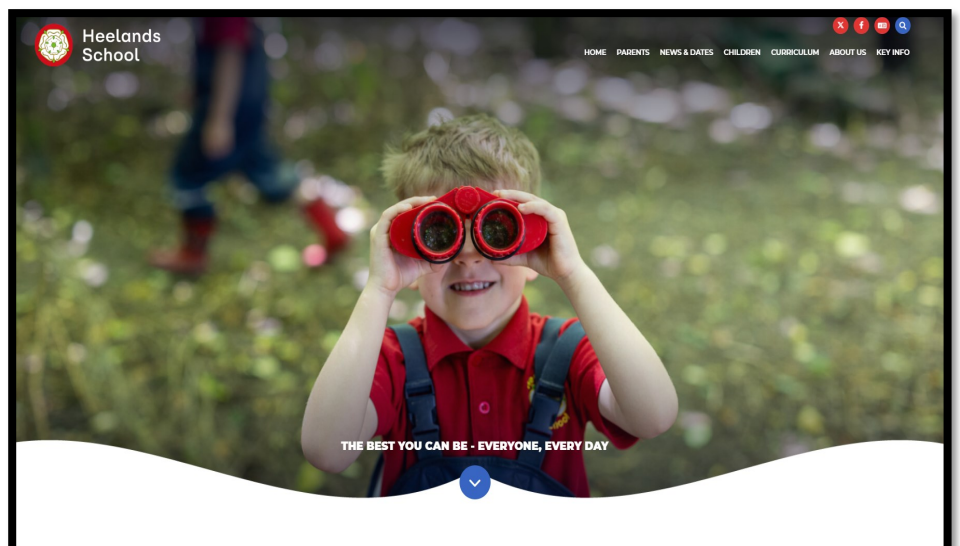
